This is Me

(Picture Conversation)



Instructions for the teacher:

- Show the picture to the children.
- Talk about the picture in their home language(s) along with English.
- Introduce the target words pointing to the pictures.
- Help the children come out with target words in English.
- Extend the conversation till every child learns the target words.
- Point to the parts of the body and help the children tell their names.
- The only objective here is to make children identify the objects and tell their names. Spelling will become our concern only after the introduction of all the letters of alphabet.

head eye nose ear leg mouth hand hair foot

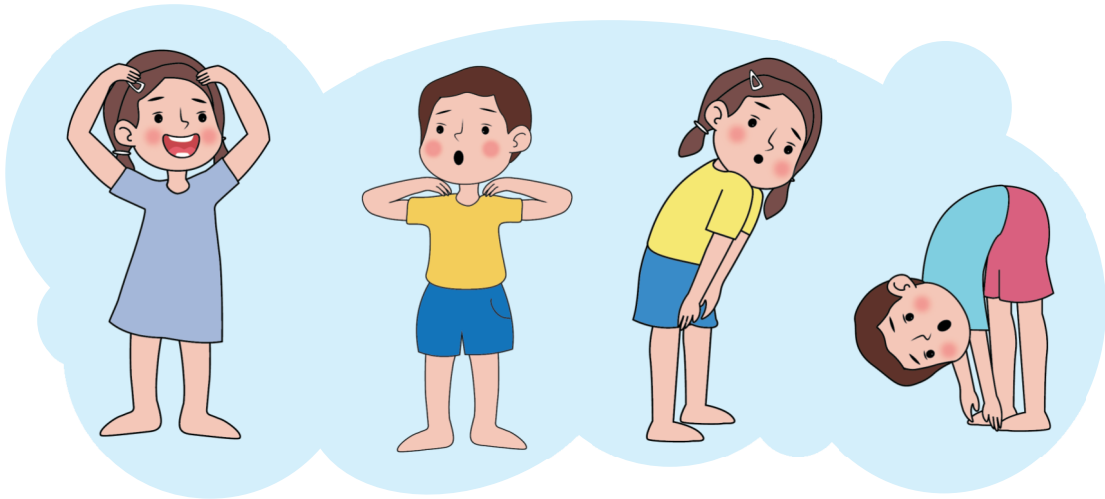


Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes

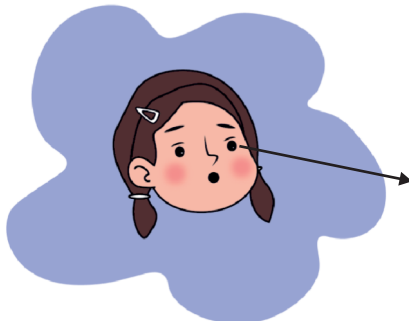
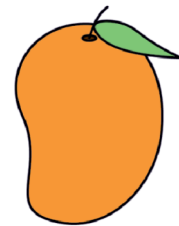
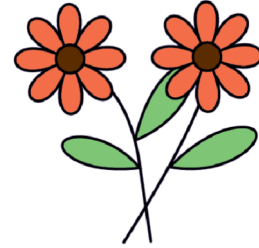
Target words –
